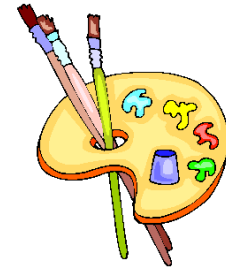
And maybe you feel you just can't measure up to them.
