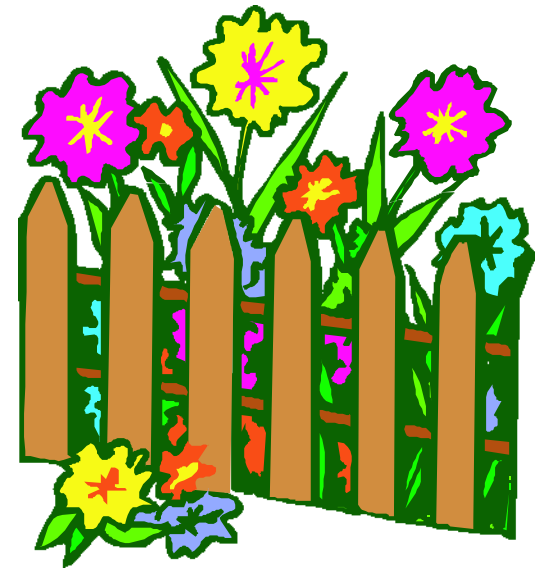
Long Journey – Friends and Heroes (DVD J Fri)
