COMMUNION PREPARERS

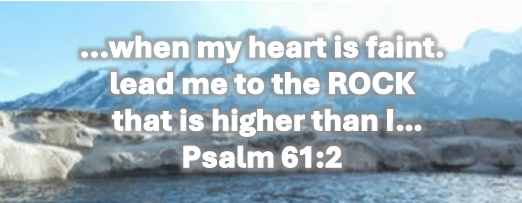


We are looking for 4 people who would be willing to prepare the Communion elements approximately 4 times a year.
