SPECIAL BUSINESS MEETING on Sept 20, 2026 to vote on postponing the Sept Business meeting one week to Oct 4th 2026.

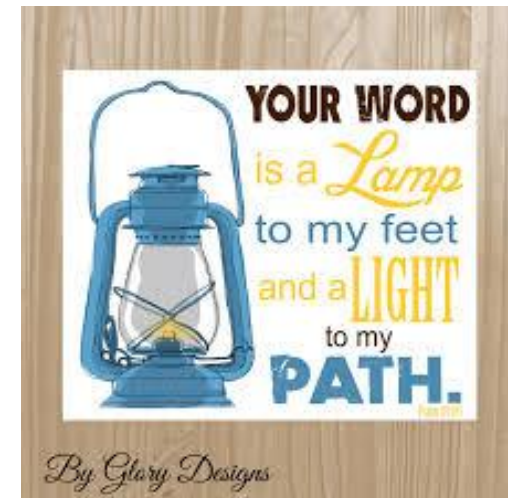
